

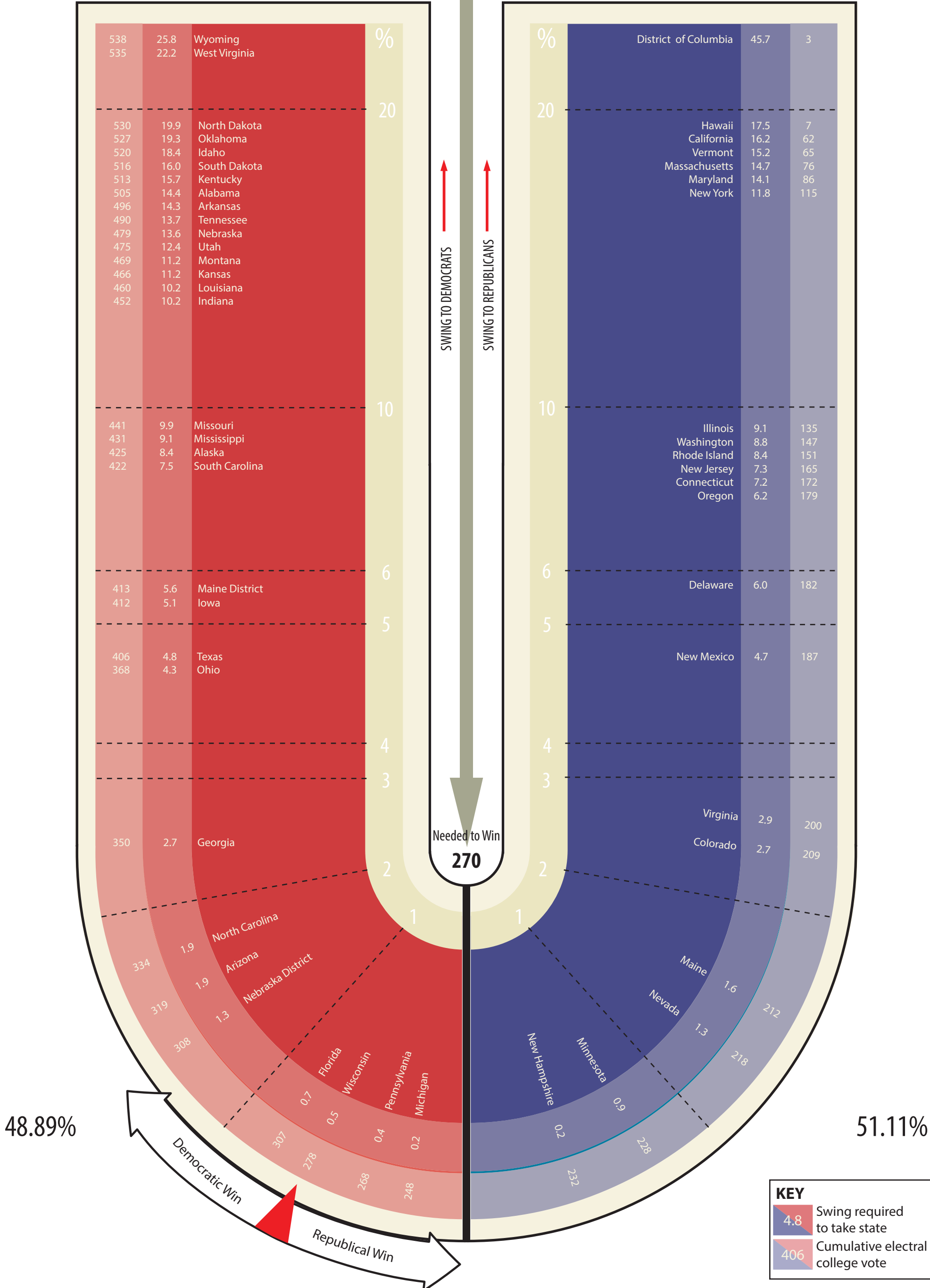

Note that the cobined vote for all other candidates was 7,830,410. Of individual candidates in that group the most significant were 4,488,919 for Gary Johnson (Libertarian), 1457,044 were for Jill Stein (Green) and 731,263 were for Evan McMullin, an Independent.
