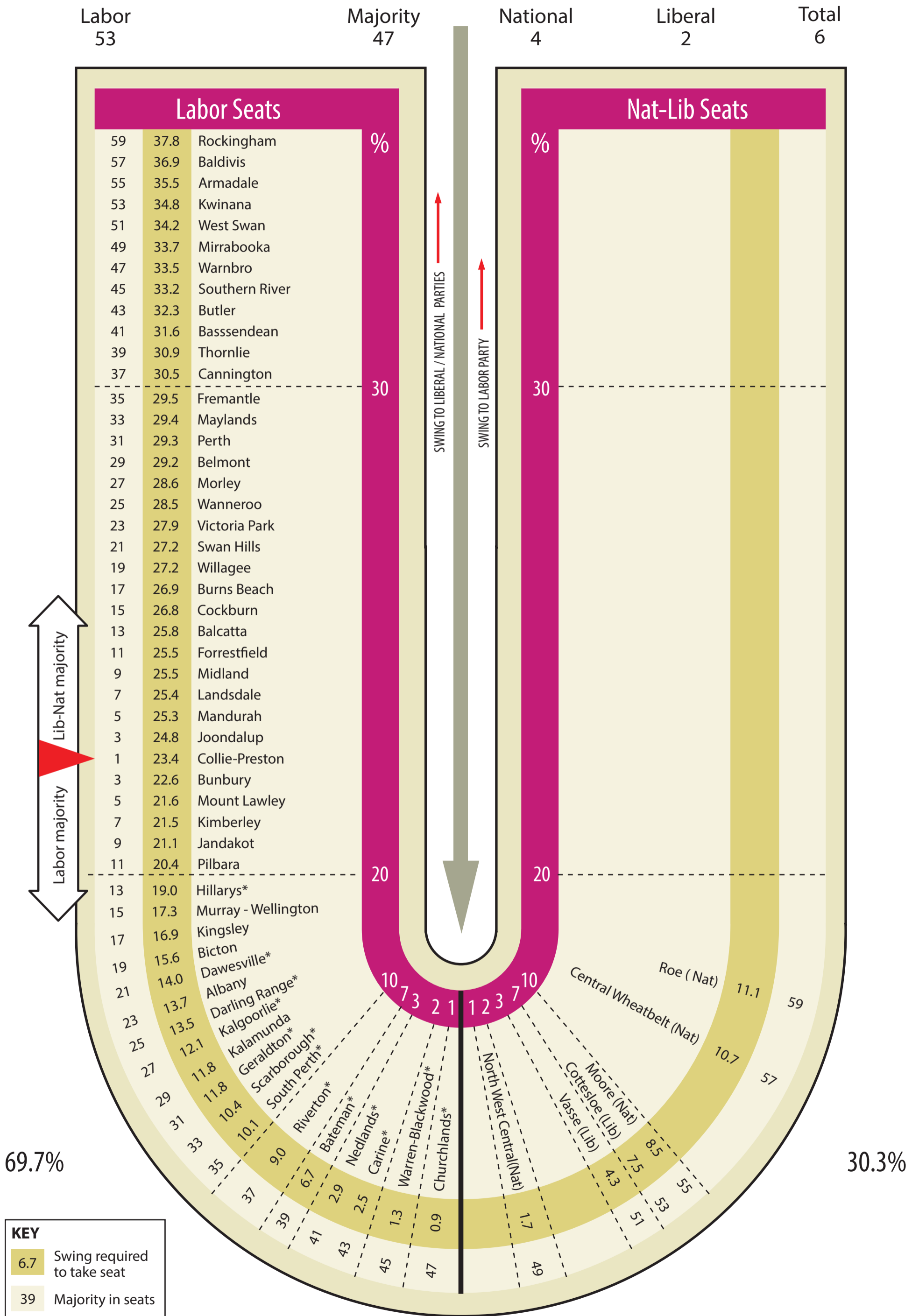


Mackerras Pendulum Western Australian Result 2021

* The contest in Fremantle was unique in that the original two-party preferred vote was between Labor and Greens. It was completed on Thursday 25 March and was 16,800 for Labor and 8,753 for Greens. That adds to 25,553. The Labor-Liberal two-party preferred vote shown here was done in a special count completed on Tuesday 20 April. It adds to 25,435. The first preference count adds to 25,581 formal votes.
